

## Criteria:

## Part One

Degrees, Diplomas, certificates, etc.

- What does your option offer? List all courses/programs available
- What are the highlights/attractions of this option?
- Where is this option located?
- What type of learners would be interested in this option?
- How would you, rate this education Option on a scale of 1-10 and explain why.
  - (1 = Don't bother! 10 = Totally worth it!)

### Part Two

Choose at least two programs (Degrees, Diplomas, certificates, etc.) that interest you.

- Research pre-requisites needed for entry
- Research duration of the program until completion
- Research cost of the program (yearly, total)

#### **Part Three**

Choose one program (Different from part two) within your option.

• How much would it cost for this option? Yearly Total? (Ex: tuition, books, fees etc.)

You must budget for a year (for this project, you must live away from home)

- Where will you live? Research monthly costs (Apartment, Campus, House, etc.)
- How will you get to and from where you are living to your program? (own a car, bus, cab)
- Groceries find out costs for one week and multiply for a rough estimate of costs
- Extras! Do you like Internet? TV? Me, too. What do they cost? Decide what you will include in your monthly budget. Leave room in your budget for entertainment.
