If you complete this assignment and you followed the instructions, and hand it in, it will be graded with a perfect score and it will likely increase your final marks.

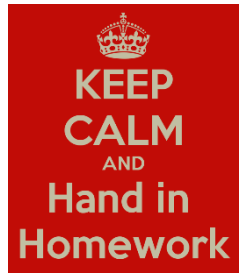
